

## ROCKCOTE Fungicidal Wash

Rockcote Fungicidal Wash is a safe and effective water based treatment for killing mosses, lichens and all types of commonly occurring fungi and algae on wall, paths, driveways and roofs. It can be used on concrete, brickwork, stone, roofing and most other building materials.

Typical uses include:

- To treat algae stains on masonry, brickwork, rendering and paintwork
- To remove moss from roof, guttering and downpipes
- Removal of lichen from carvings and decorative stonework

### APPLICATION

1. Remove all dirt and debris from areas to be treated by brushing, washing, and hosing or high pressure water jet as required.
2. Apply Rockcote Fungicidal Wash by brush, swab or spray over entire area to be coated. For external use we recommend using the product as is. For internal use we recommend using the product diluted 1 part Fungicidal Wash to 1 part water.
3. Allow the treatment to remain on the surface for not less than 24 hours.
4. After that time, again remove all debris (dead growth, loose spores etc) by washing or if possible with high pressure water jet.
5. If cycle is interrupted by rain, allow to dry and repeat steps 2 and 3.
6. Dilute Rockcote Fungicidal Wash with 1.5 times its volume of clean water (eg to 1 litre Fungicidal Wash add 1.5 litres water).
7. Apply the diluted wash to the entire area to be coated and allow to dry.
8. Coat the surface (before the next rain) with the selected Rockcote system.
9. It is important that steps 6 – 8 are carried out. Rockcote Fungicidal Wash is an effective bacterial, fungal and algal wash and is also designed to act as a residual fungicide between the substrate and surface coating. As such it will ensure that any remaining dormant spores that germinate after application of the surface coating will be killed before penetrating the coating.

### COVERAGE

Coverage is typically 3-6m<sup>2</sup> per litre.

### PACKAGING

Rockcote fungicidal wash is available in 15 litre sizes

### CLEANING

Tools and equipment should be cleaned with water immediately after use.

### STORAGE, SAFETY & HANDLING

- Rockcote fungicidal wash should be stored in a cool, dry place away from frost. Shelf life is a minimum 24 months from the date of production.
- Pails should not be stacked more than three high during transport. Pails should be stored out of direct sunlight and above 4°C.
- When working with Rockcote Fungicidal wash, it is recommended that normal protective clothing, including overalls, gloves, goggles and face protection should be worn when handling
- Contact with eye and mucous membranes should be avoided. If contact occurs, flush thoroughly with clean water.
- Where spills occur, soak up liquid spillage with sand/sawdust and dispose of in a sensible manner.
- Clean up equipment and area with water. Do not permit run-off sewer, storm water or open bodies of water. Active ingredients in large quantities can be toxic to fish.
